of olive green... You get the picture. Of course, it could just be that Lisa's literally playing the blues!

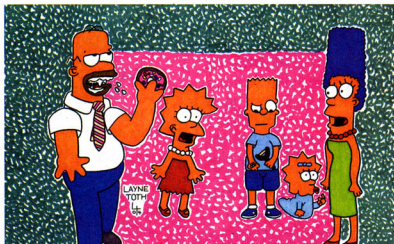
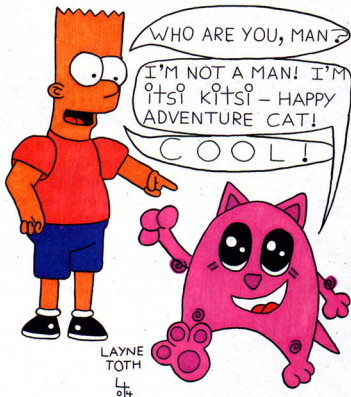
